

Günther Brück

Pianist, Composer, Arranger, Producer

Günther Brück is one of the European musicians whose compositions and arrangements can be found on several international Latin compilations repeatedly played on radio stations worldwide.

His playing style, rooted in jazz and Afro-Cuban traditions, allows him to move gracefully between the two genres.

Upon completing his jazz piano studies in Austria he moves to Cuba and, upon his return, leads the salsa band *Sin Fronteras*, later joining the Croatia-based latin/salsa band *Cubismo*, recording several CD's, giving hundreds of live concerts and TV Shows and winning eight Porin awards. He later produces the CD *Rumba para Viena* with his group *Clave Sonera* in New York.

In 2018 he receives two gold medals (Global Music Award) for his work as pianist, composer, arranger and co-producer with the production *Renacer* by Alejandra Torres and in 2019 he receives another Global Music Award in the categorie compositions/composer for his production *Entre Amigos*, his most personal album to date in which he musically reflects many of the impressions assimilated on his travels.

Günther Brück currently works as an arranger, composer and pianist, producing his own music under his *Sonerarecords* label, and works as an educator for jazz piano while also directing the Latin ensemble at the University of Music and Performing Arts, Graz, Austria.
